Today's Bible Story: I can trust God's plan, even when it's hard. Joseph in Jail • Genesis 39-40

Memory Verse: "For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord."
Jeremiah 29:11, NLT

Key Question: Who has a plan for you?

Bottom Line: God has a plan for me.

Basic Truth: God loves me.

STARTER ACTIVITY

Toy Tape

What You Need: Toys and masking or painter's tape

What You Do:

Before Activity: Place the toys on a table or hard floor in the activity area. Use one long strip of the tape to tape each toy to the table or floor.

During Activity: Challenge the children to peel the tape and free the toys. Continue the activity until each toy has been freed.

After Activity: Allow the children to play with the toys.

What You Say:

Before Activity: "Oh, no! Our toys are taped to the table."

During Activity: "Please, help me free our toys by peeling the tape. It will be a hard job, but then we can have our toys back!"

After Activity: "Whew! That was a super hard job. You did so good, and now we can play with our toys again! (Allow the children to play with the toys.) Today, we'll hear a Bible story about how we can follow God's plan, even when it is hard!"

BIBLE STORY

What You Say:

Before Video: "Today, we continue talking about a guy named Joseph. You can read all about him in the Bible. Joseph was about to do something really hard! But Joseph trusted God's plan. I can't wait to see Ollie and our friends at the Clubhouse to hear more! Here we go!"

PLAY VIDEO

“I love this story because it teaches us that we can trust God even when things are hard. Why? Because God loves us, God is with us, and God’s got a plan for us! So tell me, **who has a plan for you?**”

All Together Say: [Bottom Line] “God has a plan for me!”

Parent: “Yes! Joseph knew God had a plan, even when he faced something super-hard. And God has a plan for me and you. Let’s pray.

Prayer: “Dear God, thank You for Joseph and how he trusted Your plan, even when he faced something hard. Help us remember to trust You, always. In Jesus’ name, amen.”

FOLLOW UP ACTIVITY

Dance

What You Need: Monthly Song “Really Awesome Plan.” You can find this in the Sunday video.

What You Do:

During Activity: Turn on the music and encourage the children to dance. Repeat as desired.

What You Say:

Before Activity: “Let’s dance!”

During Activity: “When you hear the music, start dancing! We can celebrate that God has a plan for us!” (Do activity.)

After Activity: “Great job! It’s a wonderful thing that God has a plan for us! God loves us SO much! **Who has a plan for you? [Bottom Line] God has a plan for me!**”
