## STARTER ACTIVITY

### Creating Fish

**What You Need:** Play-Doh® and fish cookie cutters

### What You Do:

Before Activity: Give each child some Play-Doh.

During Activity: Encourage the children to make fish with the Play-Doh and cookie cutters.

### What You Say:

Before Activity: "Yay! It's Play-Doh time!"

During Activity: "We're going to make fish out of Play-Doh today! Use the cutters (hold up) and press them into the dough.(Demonstrate.) Look, a fish!" (Do activity.)

After Activity: "Great job! We'll hear a Bible story about fish today! I bet something AMAZING happens! I am so excited!"

## BIBLE STORY

Before Video: I'm here with a super awesome, totally amazing, TRUE story straight from the Bible. So, today's true story from the Bible begins with a group of fishermen. Let's visit Ollie and our friends at the Clubhouse to hear our TRUE Bible story today!"

### PLAY VIDEO & MEMORY VERSE VIDEO

**All Together Say:** [Bottom Line] "Jesus is amazing!"

**Girls:** Girls, who is amazing?"

**All Together Say: [Bottom Line] “Jesus is amazing!”**

**Boys:** “Boys, who is amazing?”

**All Together Say: [Bottom Line] “Jesus is amazing!”**

**Leader or Parent:** “Yes, friends! **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** Let’s talk to God. Everyone, bow your heads and close your eyes with me.”

**Prayer:** “Jesus, You can do ANYTHING! We know that You are God’s Son. Thank You for loving us and choosing to be our friend forever. We love You, Jesus, and it’s in Your name we pray, amen.”

## **FOLLOW UP ACTIVITY**

### **Memory Verse Puzzle**

**What You Need:** “Memory Verse Puzzle” Activity Page, scissors, crayons, and lunch sacks

#### **What You Do:**

During Activity: Pass out a puzzle to each child. Demonstrate how to put them together to create a fish. Point to one of the puzzles as you repeat the verse together.

#### **What You Say:**

Before Activity: “Friends, come sit at the table. I have a fun puzzle to put together today! It has a special message: our memory verse for this month. I’ll give you one BIG hint. As you put it together, it makes a fish!

During Activity: “Our puzzle says, ‘Everyone who heard him was amazed,’ Luke 2:47. Let’s say it again. ‘Everyone who heard him was amazed,’ Luke 2:47. Great job!”

After Activity: “Everyone who heard Jesus’ teaching was amazed. Everyone who saw Him send Peter out to catch all of those fish was amazed! Jesus is out-of-this-world amazing. Who is amazing? **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing.**”
