Today's Bible Story: Jesus is amazing. Healing the Blind Man • John 9:1-12

Memory Verse: "Everyone who heard him was amazed." Luke 2:47, NIV

Key Question: Who is amazing?

Bottom Line: Jesus is amazing.

Basic Truth: Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

STARTER ACTIVITY

Lead

What You Need: No supplies needed

What You Do:

During Activity: Choose one child to go first. Ask the child to close his eyes and gently lead him to another section of the room. Ask him to guess where he is and open his eyes. Repeat the activity with all of the children.

What You Say:

Before Activity: "When we walk around our room, we can see where we're going. Let's play a game and close our eyes to see if we can guess where we are."

During Activity: (Choose child to go first.) "I will lead you to a place in our room. Try to keep your eyes closed! (Do activity.) Okay, do you know where we are?" (Pause and continue the activity.)

After Activity: "Great job! Today, we'll hear a Bible story about a man who could not see. I can't wait to hear the AMAZING thing that Jesus did!"

BIBLE STORY

Before Video: Ollie and our friends at the Clubhouse are waiting to share a true story with you from the Bible. So I'm ready, how about you?" Lets go!

PLAY VIDEO & MEMORY VERSE VIDEO

"The man was so amazed. Why? Because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** Who is amazing?"

All Together Say: **[Bottom Line] "Jesus is amazing!"**

Leader or Parent: "Cover your eyes this time. Who is amazing?"

All Together Say: [Bottom Line] “Jesus is amazing!”

Leader or Parent: “Now, uncover your eyes. Who is amazing?”

All Together Say: [Bottom Line] “Jesus is amazing!”

Leader or Parent: “He sure is! Now, let’s close our eyes as we pray.”

Prayer: “Jesus, You are amazing! You made a man who was blind able to see! You can do anything. Thank You for loving us and being our friend forever. We love You, Jesus. In Your name we pray, amen.”

FOLLOW UP ACTIVITY

Making Mud

What You Need: Little People® figures, wet wipes, paper towels, plastic bowl, spoon, potting soil, and water

What You Do:

Before Activity: Invite the children to sit with you at a table.

During Activity: Give each child a figure. Mix the water and soil in a plastic bowl. As you retell the Bible story, allow the children to dip one finger in the mud, wipe it on the eyes of their toy person, then wipe the mud off. Repeat as long as time and attention allow.

After Activity: Talk about how Jesus can make people all better! **[Bottom Line]**

Jesus is amazing!

What You Say:

Before Activity: “Come sit at the table with me. We’re going to do something fun!”

During Activity: “First, everyone needs a toy person. (Give each child a toy person.) Now, we need some mud. I’ll just mix this dirt with some water . . . and now we have mud!

“Okay, dip the tip of your finger in the mud and put it on the eyes of your toy person, like Jesus did in our story. (Assist when needed.) Now, clean the mud off. That’s what Jesus did! The man couldn’t see. Jesus put mud on his eyes. And when the man washed the mud off, he could see! It was amazing! **[Bottom Line]** Jesus is amazing! Let’s do it again!” (Repeat as long as time and attention allow

After Activity: “Jesus can do things that only He can do because **[Bottom Line]** Jesus is amazing. Who is amazing? **[Bottom Line]** **Jesus is amazing!**”
